



Coin Box Description

WHAT IS IT:

The coin box is a simple way to do fundraising. We believe that every dollar, or in this case, every coin makes a difference. The purpose of the coin box is to give your Walk4Water one more way to help you reach your goal. We want everyone to feel like they can make a difference by providing clean water to someone who desperately needs it and a coin box is a great way for them to be part of making a difference!

HOW DO I USE IT:

A coin box is not effective sitting in your home or office, so find a home for it. Restaurants, coffee shops, hair salons, and doctors offices are just a few of the places where a coin box can be placed. All you have to do is ask to speak to whoever is in charge and invite them to partner with you in helping raise money for clean water by allowing a coin box to be placed in their location for a few weeks. Just remember to go back and get your coin box!

ANOTHER IDEA:

Children can be the best at fundraising, so why not give them a fun and simple assignment. Have the children find an empty bottle with a screw on lid and the wrapper removed. Make sure they wash it out first! The best bottles we have found to use are the Kroger Individual Orange Juice Bottles or the 20oz. Gatorade bottles. Both of them have wide mouth openings which make it easier to get coins into. If you want to make it into a fun craft project, you can have the children decorate their own labels and tape them to the bottle.
